## Week 2 Challenge

### Composition

Practice taking photos following the Rule of Thirds.

Draw an imaginary tic-tac-toe board on your photos. The subject of your photo should be near one of the 4 lines or the intersections of the lines.

Practice adding framing in photos.

Framing helps to emphasize the subject. Be creative about using windows, arches, trees, etc. to serve as frames in your image.

Practice incorporating leading lines into photos.

Our eyes naturally tend to follow lines in a photograph. Use this to your advantage to draw attention through the image to the subject. Be creative in using the leading lines that are all around us.



Questions to think about:

What is an example of something you used to frame a subject?

What is an example of leading lines you used in a photograph?

What are some other ways you can emphasize the subject of your photo?

Sometimes we accidentally take an amazing picture, but most of the time we have to put a lot of thought and creativity into taking photos. What are other things you use your creativity for?
