Color

Color is one of the most obvious elements of design
Color creates a mood within the piece

Color Art Challenge:

- Find a challenge sheet with instructions and three coloring sheets at https://www.geary.k-state.edu/4-h/virtual_visual_arts_lessons.html
- Color the first sheet using primary and secondary colors
 - Primary colors are red, yellow, and blue
 - Secondary colors are green, orange, and violet
- Color the second sheet using tertiary colors
 - Tertiary colors are the mixing of a primary with a secondary color
- Color the third sheet using different values of one color
 - Value refers to the lightness or darkness of a color
 - By adding white to a color, a tint is produced
 - By adding black to a color, a shade is produced

Questions to think about:

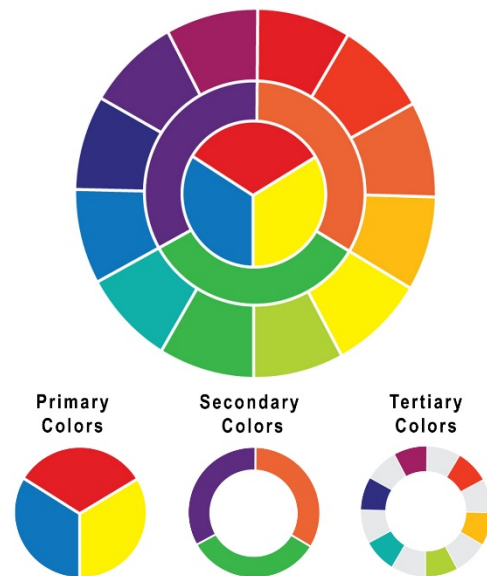
What kind of feelings do each of the primary and secondary colors evoke or make you feel?
